Vets memorial receives pair of donations

What: The Disabled Veterans' LIFE Memorial Foundation, a nonprofit organization dedicated to raising funds to design, build and maintain the nation's first memorial dedicated to disabled veterans, has received a donation of \$5,000 from the Disabled American Veterans (DAV) Gold Coast Chapter 133 in Deerfield Beach. It also has received \$25,000 from GEICO Insurance Co. Once completed, the memorial will stand on a 2-acre site adjacent to the National Mall in Washington, D.C., and its focal point will be a star-shaped reflecting pool with a single eternal flame.

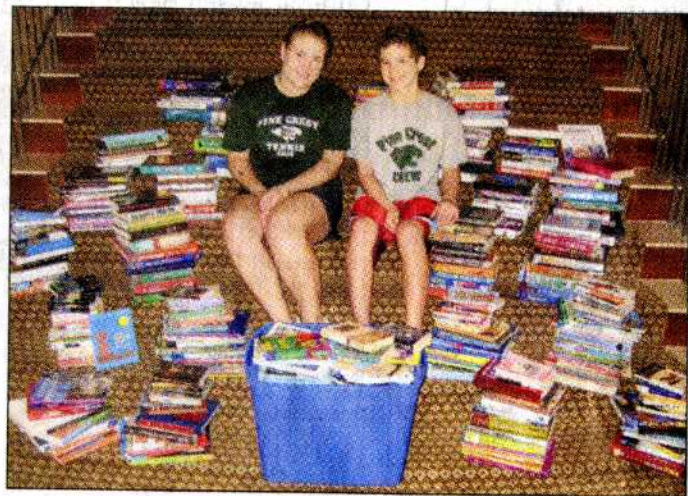
